Neil Gaiman's *The Graveyard Book* was #9 bestselling hc on the April *Locus* list; in the same issue he had the 1-2-3 top trade pbs on the Barnes and Noble/B. Dalton list (*American Gods; Fragile Things; Stardust*) and numbers 1 and 3 tp (*Coraline; American Gods*) on the Borders/Waldenbooks list.
